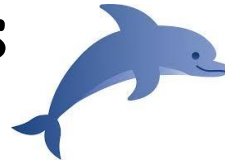

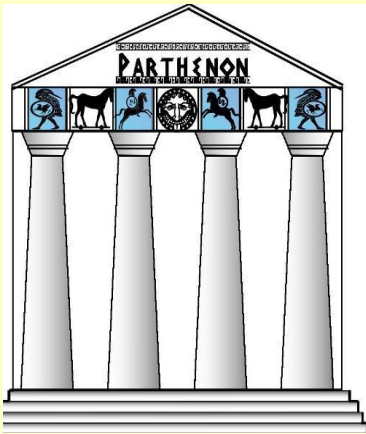
Leaping into learning

Welcome Back! Homework

We hope everybody has had a fantastic summer and is excited for the year ahead.

Our topic for this term is 'Ancient Greece'. If anyone thinks that they may have something to contribute (artefacts/books etc) please feel free to speak to Miss McCann or Mrs Alcoe.

Show and tell will take place every Friday if children wish to bring items in; this will be done on a rota basis and your child will be told when it is their week. They should be prepared to share some information and to answer questions. Please note, this must be related to something we are studying in class.



Homework - Homework is set on **Friday** to be due back the following **Wednesday**.

As part of their daily homework, all children are expected to read for at least 10 minutes every day. Please initial the reading contact book to show this has been completed.

'Tables Challenge' will take place every Friday. These should be practised as part of weekly homework.

Spellings - Spellings will be sent home on a Monday to be learnt for dictation on a Friday.

PE Kits - Please ensure children have full PE kits in school everyday. Any child without the proper kit will not be able to take part in the lesson.

Children need a change of shoes (plimsolls) to take part in the lesson. Please check all PE kit is clearly labelled as unnamed and unclaimed items go to lost property.

If children have pierced ears, they should have medical tape in school to cover them or be able to remove and put them back in independently.

*Children will be going to the paddock all year round and will need suitable trainers (in a separate plastic bag) to wear as it will be muddy.

*Please make sure girls wearing tights have a pair of socks to wear during PE.

PE is usually on Mondays and Wednesdays.

General Reminders

Water Bottles - children need a water bottle that is clearly named in school every day.

Snacks - please ensure children have a healthy snack for morning break.

Art shirts- children need an art shirt to be kept in school throughout the year to protect their uniform during messy sessions!

Reading books- Children should have a reading book in school every day. They will keep this in their packs at the table.
