



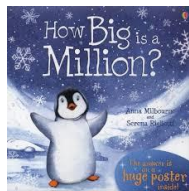

**Geography:** Maps and mapping – Castles in the UK – human and physical features

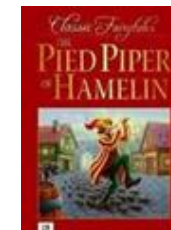
**Computing:** Using technology purposefully to save and retrieve content - E safety
