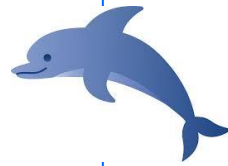

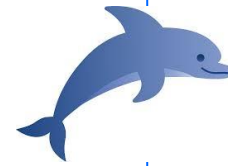

This will be a History based topic, exploring key places, people and events. We will also be learning about chronology.



Links to English and Mathematics

Year 4/5 English -

This term we will be reading *Greek myths*, working towards creating our own *Greek myth*. These will be supplemented through a study of our class story (*Percy Jackson and the lightning thief*) and exploring Aesop's fables. We will be writing non-chronological reports on mythical monsters, writing instructions with an *Ancient Greek* theme, and in poetry we will be learning about rap and riddles.

Year 4/5 Maths -

Each term builds upon the last and consolidates what they know.

The class will cover all areas of maths during the one term including number and place value, addition and subtraction (mental and formal written methods), multiplication and division (mental and formal written methods), fractions (including decimals), measurement, properties of shapes, position and direction and statistics. We will be applying our knowledge of these areas to solve problems.
