Exploring rhythm and pulse by performing through dance and a range of musical instruments.

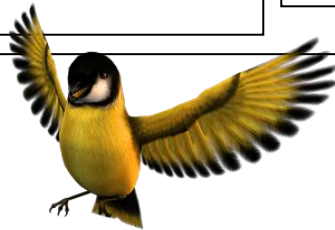
