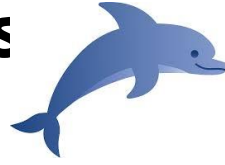

PE Kits - Please ensure children have full PE kits in school every day.

Children need a change of shoes (plimsolls) to take part in the lesson. Please check all PE kit is clearly labelled as unnamed and unclaimed items go to lost property.

If children have pierced ears, they should have medical tape in school (please give to school office) to cover them. Children are allowed to remove their earrings independently.

Children will be going to the paddock all year round and will need suitable trainers (in a separate plastic bag) to wear as it may be muddy.

Please make sure girls wearing tights have a pair of socks to wear during PE.

Children will need their swimming kits in school on Monday.

General Reminders

Water Bottles - children need a water bottle that is clearly named in school every day, especially as the weather is getting warmer.

Snacks - please ensure children have a healthy snack for morning break.

Reading books and records- Children should have a reading book and record in school every day. We expect children to be reading to an adult 3 times a week at home and this will be checked on Thursdays. We have noticed that quite a few children are not meeting this expectation during the week so it would be fantastic this term to see lots more children reaching the end of our reward scheme and getting their choice of book as a prize.
